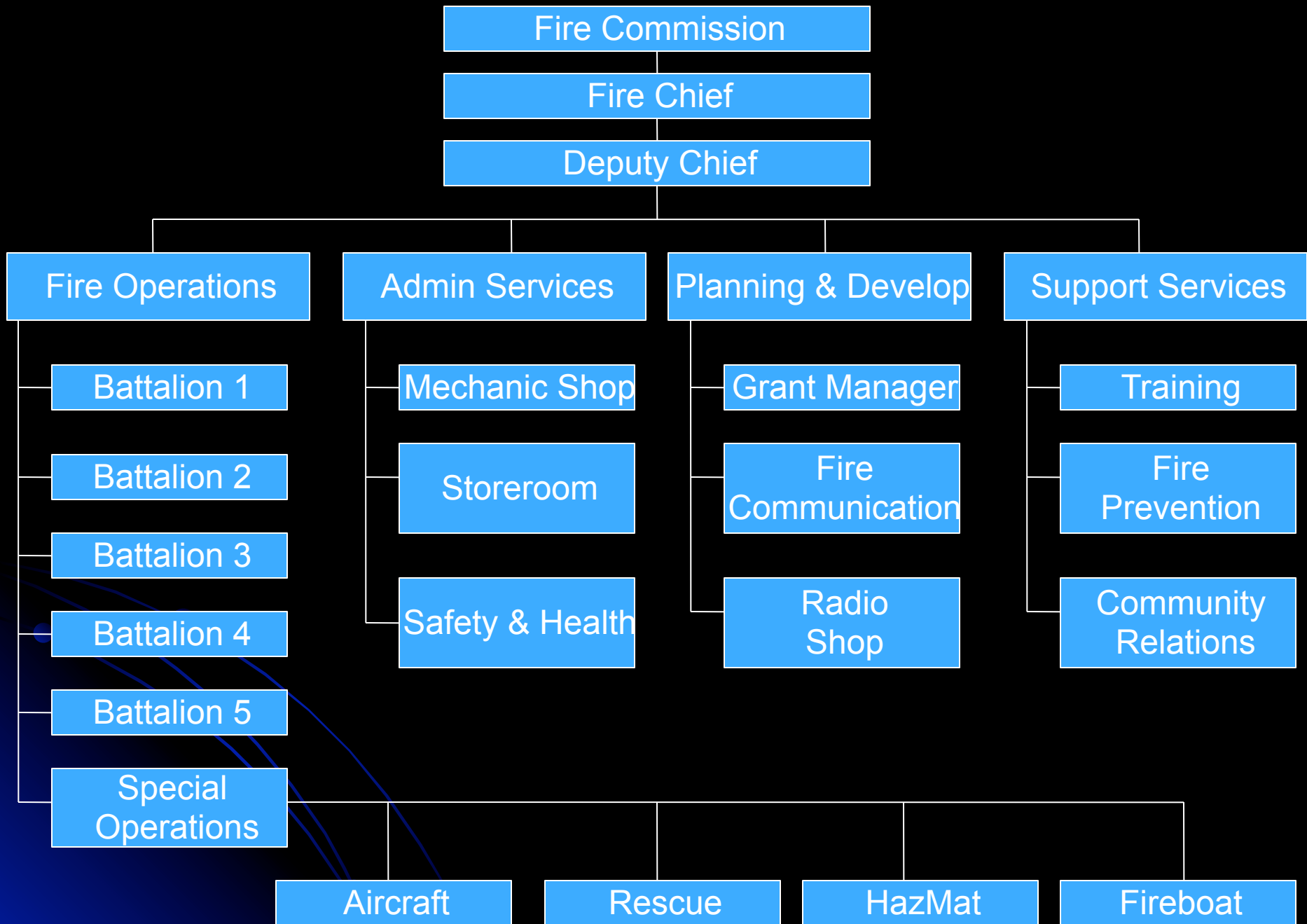




Honolulu Fire Department



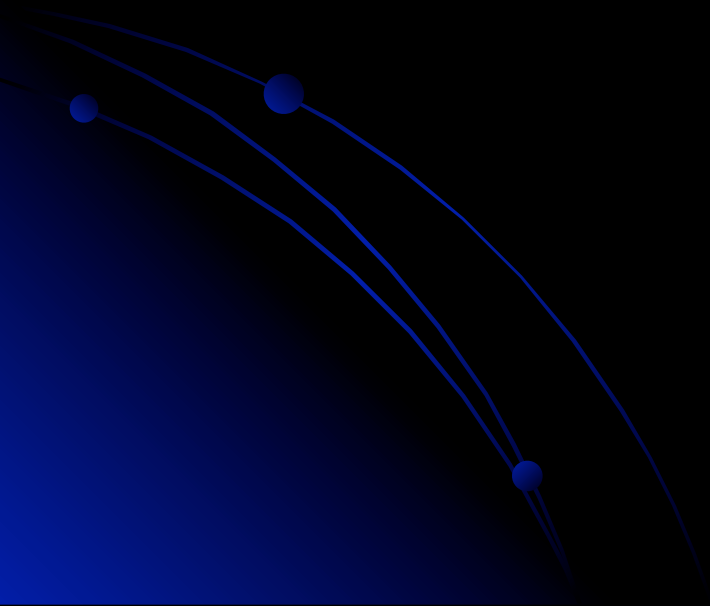
